

PROFILE

The Université Paul Cézanne Aix-Marseille 3 was founded in 1409. Today it is a comprehensive university offering an array of more than **200 national diploma programs and 120 university degrees in law, politics, economics, management, environment, science, and technology ...**

With 22 sites located principally in the cities of Aix-en-Provence and Marseille, the university enrolls more than 23,000 students, including more than 3,000 foreign students. Bilingual French-English programs appeal to many international students.

Major fields of study

The university is composed of teaching and research faculties in law, applied economics, science, and technology, plus a school of business administration (IAE), an institute of political studies (IEP), an institute of public administration, the Institut Universitaire de Technologie de Marseille, an institute of French studies for international students, and eight university vocational institutes. Its 42 recognized research laboratories make it a center of international excellence in the social and natural sciences.

Strengths

Numerous services give students the resources and tools they need to succeed—among them libraries, computer facilities, language laboratories, and an athletic program featuring more than 50 sports.

International students enrolled under official exchange programs or French government scholarships are housed in the Cité Universitaire. All students have ample opportunities to participate in the rich social and cultural life of the region.

As a university in motion and a regional leader in research and education, the Université Paul Cézanne has added an international dimension to its strategy. With more than 180 cooperative agreements, it is helping to build Europe's research and education program. A policy of engagement with developing countries in Asia (China, in particular) has led it to multiply its collaborative activities and to considerably increase its enrollments of excellent international students.

Location

Thanks to its exceptional location in the heart of Europe and near the Mediterranean Sea, the Université Paul Cézanne has developed relationships with its German, Italian, and Spanish neighbors, as well as the countries of the Mediterranean region. Numerous bilateral and multilateral accords foster research and exchanges of students and faculty.
