PROFILE

The Université de Bourgogne offers academic and professional programs in all scientific disciplines, including the health sciences.

The university is composed of 22 units-11 academic faculties, 4 schools of engineering, and 7 institutes, including 1 devoted to viticulture and oenology.

The student body of more than 26,000 includes 10% international students from 100 different countries.

The university offers a wide variety of degree programs:

- Short professional programs (2-3 years, leading to a DUT or licence professionnelle)
 - Longer university programs (3, 5, or 8 years, leading to a licence, master's degree, or doctorate)
 - Engineering degree programs (5 years)
 - International programs (1 integrated Franco-German program, 1 Erasmus Mundus master's programs)
 - Various degree programs specific to the Université de Bourgogne
 - Specialized training in French as a foreign language
- All programs carry credit (ECTS).

Major fields of study

- Administrative law - French public and private law, European and international law, sports law, political science, public administration, economic and social administration
- Economics-management-marketing - Economics, management, marketing, accounting, business, insurance, banking, finance
- Literature-languages-culture-communication - Modern and classic literature, philosophy, information sciences and media, management of cultural programs, foreign languages and cultures, applied foreign languages
- Humanities and social sciences - History, geography, psychology, sociology, music theory, history of art, archaeology, education
- Science-technology-health - Mathematics, physics, chemistry, computer science, mechanics, biochemistry, biology, environmental and earth sciences, viticulture and oenology, food science, medicine, pharmacy
- Athletics and physical education - Training and conditioning, sports management, sports tourism, applied physical activity

Research

The research programs of the Université de Bourgogne are organized into 3 major groups: humanities and social sciences, physical sciences and technology, and life and earth sciences. More than 1,000 doctoral candidates (25% from abroad) are enrolled in 49 research units. More than 200 doctoral dissertations are being prepared under joint supervision.

Strengths

The Centre International d'Etudes Françaises (international center for French studies) enrolls more than 1,000 students in French language programs during the summer and academic year. The Université de Bourgogne also offers distance-learning programs.

The university provides an excellent technical and digital environment, campus facilities housing more than 40 different athletic activities, and a wide range of social and cultural events and special-interest clubs.

Care is taken to ensure that international students become well integrated into student life. The international student program includes a week-long orientation, tutoring by French students, and a one-stop-shop for compliance with administrative and regulatory requirements.

Location

The main campus of the Université de Bourgogne is in Dijon, the capital of the Burgundy region. The campus occupies 115 landscaped hectares bordering the city center.

With a population of 250,000, the Dijon metropolitan area is 1 hour and 40 minutes from Paris by high-speed train and 2 hours from Lyon. It lies at the intersection of several major highways.

Five regional campuses are located in Chalon-sur-Saône, Mâcon, Le Creusot, Auxerre, and Nevers.

The Burgundy region is rich in history and culture. Gastronomy and wine-making are among its many claims to fame.
