In addition to degree programs, Sciences Po boasts prominent programs in continuing education, research, and publishing. Sciences Po's goal is to train future leaders in business, national government, international institutions, research bodies, and nongovernmental organizations. Sciences Po is located in one of the most delightful quarters of Paris. Since the 17th century, Saint Germain des Prés has been the nexus of the city's literary and artistic life.

Paris is the heart of Europe, just 135 minutes from London and 140 minutes from Brussels by train, and just 90 minutes by air from Barcelona, Rome, and Berlin.
